As previously discussed, the dumpsters at the hall continue to be misused. Small items and bags are acceptable if you miss or forget trash collection. Please do not place large items in the township hall parking lot; this has been occurring and is unacceptable. Large items may be collected from your home free of charge by calling Republic Services. Typically, two spring clean-up dumpsters are placed at the hall mid-April. Dumpsters are filled on a first come first serve basis; please be mindful of dumpster capacity, respectful to fellow residents, and do not overfill. If misuse (excessive overfilling, large item abandonment, etc.) of these township services persists, this service will be reconsidered and may be discontinued.

Summer tax office hours are Tuesdays 9:00-4:00 July 5-Sept 13, and September 14 9:00-5:00. Winter office hours are Tuesdays, 9:00-4:00 Dec 6-Feb 7, 2023, and February 14, 2023, 9:00-5:00. The last day to pay winter taxes at the township office is February 28, 2023. To pay taxes by mail, make check or money order payable to Garfield Township and mail to Garfield Township Treasurer, 1138 W Erickson Rd, Linwood, MI 48634. To save postage, place payment in the drop slot of the door at the main entrance of the Hall. To pay by preauthorized ach please fill out the form enclosed with your banking information and signed approval. Deferred tax and preauthorized tax forms are available on the township website on the Treasurer's tab. If a receipt is required, please enclose a self-address stamped envelope with your payment. NO POSTMARKS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER DATE TAXES ARE DUE.
